Dear Parents:

The health forms you are receiving today are due back by the first day of school. They are being sent now so parents will be aware of what is needed and have enough time to fulfill these requirements prior to the opening of school in September. The health forms are required to be filled out and signed by the doctor if your child is entering one of the following grades in September: **Pre-K, Kindergarten, 3rd, 6th, & 9th grades**. The information recorded on the physical is vital in updating the nurse on the medical status of each student.

If your child is due for any immunizations before the start of the new school year in September, a letter will be attached indicating what is needed. It is mandatory that written documentation be submitted on or before the first day of school in September, stating the dates the immunizations were given and signed by the doctor. According to New Jersey State Law, students are not allowed to start school in September without having these immunizations given already.

If your child requires any medication to be given during the current school year, permission consent forms can be obtained in advance from the Main Office or Nurse's Office. Any child on medication this year in school, will automatically be sent a new form. The consent form must be signed by both the doctor and the parent in order to be valid. All prescription medication must be labeled by the pharmacist and sent to school in original bottles with the child's name on it. If your child is using an inhaler and must keep it with him/her at all times, there is a special consent form the doctor can sign giving permission for this. It is called the self-administered inhaler permission form and is available in the Nurse's Office. Otherwise, all medication will be kept locked in the Nurse's Office.

If your child has the need for Tylenol or Advil use during the school year, a medication consent form will enable the nurse to give as needed.
