- 100 index cards –either separate or spiral bound
- One clear plastic ruler with black numbers, not flexible!
- Calculators are necessary. Purchase only the TI-30Xa Texas Instruments scientific calculator! All others are confusing to beginner users. The cost is \$10. (There is a chance that we may need to use a graphing calculator. I'm going to try and wait until Pre-Calculus, so don't purchase one yet.)
- One set of white board markers.
- Pouch to store and carry math supplies



I know that it's still summer, but I'm already thinking about the fun we'll have learning math together!

Here is the list of required supplies for Grade 7 math:

- Many pencils. Either yellow wooden pencils (Ticonderoga is the best.) or mechanical pencils. Do not get the kind with plastic coated pictures – they dull the pencil sharpener!
- One ream of paper (500 sheets).
- One protractor – clear plastic, cheapest one in the store only! This is the easiest one to use.
- One clear plastic ruler with black numbers, not flexible!
- 50 index cards – spiral bound is great
- Calculators are only necessary for a few lessons at the end of the year. If you purchase one, buy only the TI-30Xa Texas Instruments scientific calculator. All others are confusing to beginner users and this one can also be used in 8th grade math and Algebra class. The cost is \$10.
- One set of white board markers.
- Pouch to store and carry math supplies

Welcome to 6th Grade Math Class

- One protractor – clear plastic, cheapest one in the store only! This is the easiest one to use.
- One clear plastic ruler with black numbers, not flexible!

- One pad of graph paper
- One ream (500 sheets) of white paper
- Pouch to store and carry math supplies (ruler will not fit inside 😊)
